  email. Please make sure that the church has your accurate email address.
- Church Community Builder is our online centralized volunteer scheduling system. This will be used for all volunteer scheduling.

# **Scheduling Conflicts:**

- Serving schedules are distributed through Church Community Builder.
- If you have a conflict with a date that you are scheduled to serve, please recruit someone who would be willing to fill in for you.
- Once you have found a substitute, please inform your team leader of the change

#### **Dress Guidelines:**
